To Whom It May Concern:

This letter has been written to verify the VOC content of <u>Titebond Original Wood Glue</u>. The current VOC content of this product is 0.11 g/L. This amount is less than the current VOC content limits of California's South Coast Air Quality Management District's (SCAQMD) Rule #1168 for Wood Substrate Adhesives which has a VOC content limit of 30 g/L.

Additionally, Titebond Original Wood Glue has passed California Department of Public Health CDPH/EHLB/Standard Method Version 1.2, 2017 (Emission testing method for CA Specification 01350). This is a requirement for obtaining LEED v4.1 low emitting materials credit. Please note that the VOC emissions certificate was issued on January 11, 2024.
